FEATURED PRESENTERS

CORA MUNOZ, Ph.D, R.N is a professor of nursing at Capital University. She completed her Doctor of Philosophy degree from the Ohio State University in Counselor Education. She is a national and international speaker on health & culture and nursing and is an accomplished author of several articles on transcultural health and cultural competency. Dr. Munoz recently published a book entitled “Transcultural Communication in Nursing” and was a contributing author to the text “Determining nursing diagnosis through assessment”. In 2010, she was awarded a participant scholar to the Health Disparities, Translational Research, Practice & Policy intensive training at NIH/NCMHD.

MICHAEL MACK graduated from the Writing Program at MIT. He has inspired audiences nationwide with his award-winning solo show. He was a little boy when his mother was first diagnosed with schizophrenia. In his multi-character one-man show Mack charts his mother’s odyssey through state hospitals, halfway houses, jails, and homelessness until she finds recovery through an unexpected grace. Exploring the shadowy landscape between psychosis and religious illumination, Hearing Voices (Speaking in Tongues) is one family’s journey of deliverance. Awards include an Artist’s Grant for new theater works from the Massachusetts Cultural Council, First Prize in the Writers Circle National Poetry Competition, and an Eloranta Fellowship, which funded a residency at the Tyrone Guthrie Centre for the Arts in Ireland.
